Beer Cocktails

While hardly routine in North America, beer cocktails appear commonly in many parts of Europe. These are our own contributions to the field.

Black Beauty \$5.98 half-litre
Québec \$4.06/300 ml
+/- 5.25% alcohol

This is our take on the British drink, Stout and Black, except instead of Ribena and Guinness, we blend Unibroue's Éphémère Cassis with Brasserie McAuslan's St. Ambroise Oatmeal Stout.

Bourbon Black & Tan \$10.75/300 ml
Ontario, Québec & Kentucky
+/- 8.7% alcohol

A traditional Black & Tan, built with St. Ambroise Oatmeal Stout and Black Oak Nut Brown Ale, made deliciously different with the addition of an ounce of the legendary bourbon from Maker's Mark.

Coffee and a Smoke \$8.45/half-litre
Ontario
+/- 6% alcohol

We take an entire bottle of Mill Street Coffee Porter and top up the glass with Church Key Holy Smoke to create a softly smoky, very coffee-ish porter with just a hint of fruitiness.

Drill Sergeant \$7.48/300 ml
Ontario and Cuba

For this British Navy-inspired drink, we add a shot of Havana Club Amber Rum to a glass of the hoppy, 'Old School-Style' Sergeant Major IPA.

Orange de Chambly \$4.70/350 ml
Québec and Florida
+/- 3.75% alcohol

Three parts Blanche de Chambly made even more refreshing with the addition of one part orange juice. Think of a mimosa with a beer twist.

Snoreffe \$4.70/300 ml

The slightly tart and spicy fruitiness of Snoreau gets a chocolaty, malty boost with an equal amount of Leffe Brune.
